

2014 Season "Up To 10 Entry" Punch Cards

Purchase your punch cards in advance at the Apple Valley Community Center, 14603 Hayes Road, and at the pools during the season. Be advised, all cards expire after the 2014 season.

Resident Multi-Pack Punch Cards

Offered to **Apple Valley residents** who wish to purchase multiple punch cards. With each additional punch card up to four purchased, a substantial savings is made. If a fifth card is purchased, the pack rate will start over.

NOTE: To receive the resident multi pack rate, all purchases must be made at the same time.

Summer Swimming Lessons at Redwood Community Pool

All classes are Monday through Thursday for two weeks. Classes postponed due to poor weather will be made up on the Friday of that week. There are no make-up lessons for individuals who miss a class. You can only attend the class and session for which you are registered. **Call the Weather Hotline for the latest information on weather related facility closings at 952-953-2399.**

Registration & Costs

Register at www.cityofapplevalley.org

Parent/Child and Tadpole Splash are \$39.00 per eight class session. Levels 1-6 are \$59.00 per eight class session. Payment must accompany registration. Registration for each session closes one week prior to session start. Please register for all sessions in which you would like to participate. We will transfer children to other skill levels if they are not correctly assigned only if space is available in the appropriate level and the child is currently registered in a class during the same session. Children are unlikely to advance from one level to the next in a single eight class session. We recommend that they be registered in the same level each session unless you are advised otherwise by the child's instructor. We will give priority to children on the waiting list for each class if space becomes available, so we strongly encourage waiting list registration for all classes your wish to enter.

Cancellations: The City of Apple Valley reserves the right to cancel any class for lack of registration no later than the Thursday prior to the session start date.

Private Swimming Lessons at Redwood Pool

Having a hard time fitting swimming lessons into our summer schedule? Why not try private instruction by appointment with one of our Red Cross trained swimming instructors? Form your own class of up to three swimmers of similar ability or work one on one with one of our Red Cross trained Water Safety Instructors. Contact Steve Skinner, Recreation Supervisor for details at **952-953-2314** or speak directly to the Pool Manager when you are at Redwood.

What Level is best?

Parent/Child (P/C): For infants and toddlers ages six months to three years accompanied by parent.

Tadpole Splash (TS): For the young or fearful child. Children must be 3 or 4 years old. Level 1 skills will be introduced at a gradual pace.

Level 1: For the child who has not yet learned to float but is not fearful of the water (we recommend Tadpole Splash for the fearful child).

Level 2: Ready to attempt floating on the front and back unsupported.

Level 3: Can swim the width of the pool using basic crawl and winging. Diving is introduced.

Level 4: Swimming widths using the front and elementary back strokes.

Level 5: Can swim the length of the pool using front crawl, back crawl, butterfly, breaststroke and elementary backstroke.

Level 6: Ready to swim laps using all strokes previously introduced.

Adult (A): For adults who wish to begin learning to swim.

If your young swimmer would like to become an American Red Cross Lifeguard soon (age 15 is the minimum for Lifeguard Training Certification through the American Red Cross), then here is a chance to get started. For children and teens ages 10 - 14 this program is appropriate for any young person living near water, as well as those interested in becoming a Lifeguard or Camp Counselor. This program is an American Red Cross introduction to living and working safely around the water. This is a fun filled program that covers a wide variety of topics relating to water safety and the physical conditioning necessary to be a top notch Lifeguard. Materials include a workbook and a passport to water safety as a record of achievement. Participants should be ready to enter the water at all class sessions. THE PROGRAM: You will receive a program manual during the first week of classes. The program is geared toward the recreational skater of all ages and skill levels. Instructors will follow the skill progressions outlined in our program manual. Skaters will be evaluated throughout the session to determine if they are ready to advance. Our program consists of a 12:1 student/instructor ration to ensure quality instruction. The exception being the Pre Beginner level which is an 8:1 ratio.

REGISTRATION: Registration for our program is conducted on-line. Go to the City's website at www.cityofapplevalley.org. From the "Recreation" heading's drop-down lists, select "Recreation Programs" and then "Ice Skating Lessons". First-time users will need to set up an account to register. Each family member should be listed on the same account, and can be easily added at a later date.

COST: \$75.00 per skater which includes eight half-hour lessons and eight half-hour practices.

REQUIREMENTS: We recommend children in the Pre-Beginner classes wear a helmet (bike helmets work well) and snow pants. Freestyle skaters should wear form-fitting clothes or skating attire so instructors can view the proper movement of required elements. All skaters must wear gloves. Double runner skates are not permitted. Skate rental is available at a cost of \$2.00 per pair per session; however, there is a limited supply of skates in each size. Skate sharpening is available for \$4.00 per pair of skates.

WHAT CLASS DOES MY SKATER SIGN UP FOR?

If your skater is 3 or 4 years old and has never skated before, you should sign up for the Pre-Beginners class. If you have previously skated in our program and not sure what class to register for, please contact the Skating Staff at ktesky@cityofapplevalley.org.

Please Note: There is no age requirement for levels other than Pre-Beginner which is ages 3-4. Ice Rental available at \$160/hour. Schedule your birthday party or other group skating event by calling the Arena at **952-953-2366**.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

PRE-BEGINNER: Designed for 3-4 year olds with little or no skating experience.

BEGINNER: (Levels 1-4) Designed for 5 and older with little or no skating experience. Will work on forward/backward skating and stopping.

ADVANCED BEGINNER A: (Levels 1-3) Designed for those who have passed Beginners or those with some skating experience. The curriculum helps the skater to become more proficient at performing basic elements of recreational figure skating, including jumps, spins, and crossovers.

ADVANCED BEGINNER B: (Levels 4-6) Designed for those who have passed Advanced Beginners 3 or equivalent skills. The curriculum helps the skater to become more proficient at performing basic elements of recreational figure skating, including jumps, spins, and crossovers.

FREESTYLE: This is the beginning of freestyle skating.


