

MARKERS

- Markers are permitted in the Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley subject to Cemetery regulation.
- The City is not responsible for the purchase, installation, or maintenance of any Marker. The burden of keeping the Marker in a safe and proper state of repair shall be on the Lot Owner, his heirs or assigns.
- No Marker or any part thereof may be constructed of wood, limestone, sandstone, or any other material which is not approved by the Cemetery Supervisor. Solar lights are not allowed in Lebanon Cemetery.
- The Marker Locating Fee **must be paid in full** prior to the Marker installation.
- Installation of the Marker shall be performed by the Marker manufacturer or manufacturer's agent. All Markers shall be placed as directed by the Cemetery Supervisor.
- The top of the Marker **shall be set level** with the grade.
- A concrete border four (4) inches wide and four (4) inches thick is required around all Markers.
- Markers, including the concrete border, shall not exceed 80 percent of the lots upon which they rest.
- The Marker's concrete border on Cremation Lots measuring forty-two (42) inches square shall not exceed twenty (20) inches in depth.
- A maximum of one (1) Marker is allowed on a single Cremation Grave Lot and a maximum of three (3) Markers is allowed on a single Traditional Grave Lot.
- Markers may be placed prior to the burial of the deceased.

MONUMENTS

- Monuments are permitted in the Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley subject to Cemetery regulation.
- The City is not responsible for the purchase, installation, or maintenance of Monuments. The burden of keeping the Monument in a safe and proper state of repair shall be on the Lot Owner, his heirs or assigns.
- No Monument or any part thereof may be constructed of wood, limestone, sandstone, or any other material which is not approved by the Cemetery Supervisor. Solar lights are not allowed in Lebanon Cemetery.
- The Monument Locating Fee **must be paid in full** prior to the Monument installation.
- Installation of the Monument shall be performed by the Monument manufacturer or manufacturer's agent. All Monuments shall be placed as directed by the Cemetery Supervisor.
- Monument placement shall be made so as to allow and facilitate the use of mechanical cleaning and mowing equipment.
- Each Monument shall be placed on a concrete foundation which will be a minimum thickness of four (4) inches; the top of the foundation shall be set level with the grade; the base of the Monument shall be a minimum of four (4) inches from the edge of the concrete foundation.
- No Monument shall be placed on less than two (2) Traditional or Cremation Grave Lots. The maximum Monument size the City shall allow is eighty (80) percent, or six (6) feet eight (8) inches, whichever is less, of the purchased lot width, including concrete border; and a depth of two (2) feet on Traditional Grave Lots or twenty (20) inches on Cremation Grave Lots, including concrete border; unless otherwise approved by the Cemetery Supervisor.
- Monuments are only permitted in designated Monument Row(s).
- Monuments may be placed prior to the burial of the deceased.

MEMORIALS

The deceased may be memorialized with either a Marker or Monument depending on the lot selected. Lebanon Cemetery requires lots to be marked with a permanent Marker or Monument within one year of interment. Permanently unmarked graves are not allowed.

The City does not purchase or install Markers or Monuments. They may be purchased from a vendor of your choosing. All Markers and Monuments must meet Cemetery regulations. A drawing of the Marker or Monument shall be submitted to the City prior to fabrication. The drawing shall show the width and depth of the Marker or the width, depth, and height of the Monument and base; width and depth of the concrete border or foundation; and the proposed material, finish, lettering, and carving design.

Vases or containers integrated into a Marker or Monument may be allowed subject to approval by the Cemetery Supervisor.

The City requires a 3-day notification prior to the installation of a Marker or Monument.

MARKERS

A Marker is a flat stone or other suitable material set at grade level and inscribed with the name of the deceased and any other pertinent information.

All lots are designated Marker privileged. Markers may be placed on single or multiple lots.


MONUMENTS

A Monument is a stone or other suitable material set above grade level and inscribed with the name of the deceased and any other pertinent information.

A Monument may be placed on two or more lots in Monument Privileged Rows. Monuments are not permitted on single lots or on lots not designated Monument Privileged.
