

Welcome to the 2016 Adult Softball Season in Apple Valley!

The City of Apple Valley's Parks and Recreation Department will be offering a wide variety of leagues, from recreational level (lower D/E) to the more intermediate (D) level of play. Men's doubleheader leagues will be offered Sunday through Thursday evenings. We will also provide two separate Co-rec doubleheader leagues on Friday evenings. (Recreational lower D/E, and an Intermediate D, level of play.

***New this year will be adding PLAY-OFFS for ALL TEAMS at the end of the regular league season. These play-off games will be on the same night as your team's regular league games.**

New resident teams as well as all returning teams from last summer will have until February 18 to reserve a spot in this year's softball league program. Returning fall 2015 teams will be able to register beginning Monday February 22. Starting Thursday February 25 all NEW TEAM registrations will begin. Teams may continue registering until all leagues are filled.

This year, we will be offering an 11 week, 22 game season and an end the season play-off tournament for all of our teams. (Play-offs will be a single elimination with consolation bracket tournament, an additional 2 to 5 games!) We will also host our 3rd Annual "All City League Championship Tournaments" on Saturday September 10 2016.

Each league championship team will receive league championship t-shirts as well as a team championship plaque. The league championship team and the league runner- up will also receive a team gift card to a local Apple Valley restaurant/business. All of our softball leagues are sanctioned and affiliated with the USSSA Softball program. All of our teams are eligible for MRPA/USSSA regional and state play to the extent teams choose to go on from local league play. All of our umpires are required to be trained and certified as USSSA umpires.

Our leagues also provide an onsite field supervisor, an evening park maintenance representative (to help maintain the fields at the optimal field condition) and a concession stand. We have five lit fields that are all fully fenced and irrigated.

League information will be emailed to all of last year's summer and fall softball teams the last week of January and the 2016 softball league information and registration information will be posted on this website on January 28.
