1. **Registration:** ONLINE ONLY. Visit City's website at www.cityofapplevalley.org/police. Click on the Night to Unite News Flash on home page. THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER IS JULY 26.
2. **Street Closure:** This year we are trying something new regarding street closures. You will no longer be required to pick up barricades from the Central Maintenance Facility. Instead, you will be given yellow "Caution" tape in your coordinator pack and will tie that to objects (lawn chairs, garbage cans, bikes, etc.) at the end of your street for the closure. This is only good for NTU events.
3. **Going Green:** Recycling containers available for neighborhood parties. Contact Dakota Valley Recycling at 952-895-4511 by July 22 to reserve your container.
4. **Yard Signs:** Yard signs will only be given to neighborhoods organizing for the first time. You are responsible for keeping your Night to Unite yard sign in a safe place from year to year. We WILL NOT be able to accommodate requests for replacement/extra signs this year.
5. **Coordinator Pack Pick Up:** Coordinator packs containing a gift card from a local retailer will again be available for registered parties. Please arrange for your pack to be picked up at the Police Lobby the week of July 26-July 29 between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. **NEW NIGHT HOURS: Tues. Jul 26 or Thurs. July 28 between 4:30 p.m.—8 p.m.** PLEASE DO NOT COME IN BEFORE JULY 26 TO COLLECT YOUR PACK. (NO MONDAY PICK UP).
6. **Business Watch Picnic:** Apple Valley Business Watch will be hosting a Night to Unite picnic from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at Kelley Park. The picnic will again feature food trucks!! Goody bags and raffle prizes will also be available.
