August 2, 2016

140th Street from Cedar Avenue to Diamond Path

- Monday, August 8 - Removal and grinding of the existing striping from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. There will be single lane closures on 140th Street to accommodate work in the traffic lane.
- Tuesday / Wednesday, August 9 & 10 - Micro surfacing application is schedule to start after 7 p.m. and end by 6 a.m. There will be single lane closures on 140th Street to accommodate work in the traffic lanes. The signal systems along 140th Street at Galaxie Avenue, Flagstaff Avenue, Johnny Cake Ridge Road, and Pilot Knob Road will be set to “flash” during this time. All lanes are planned to be open by 6 a.m.
- Thursday / Friday, August 11 & 12 - Re-striping is scheduled to start after 7 p.m. and will include single lane closures to accommodate work in the traffic lanes. The signal systems along 140th Street at Galaxie Avenue, Flagstaff Avenue, Johnny Cake Ridge Road, and Pilot Knob will be set to “flash” during this time. All lanes are planned to be open by 6 a.m.

The Oaks, Summerfield and Diamond Valley Estates Neighborhoods

- Thursday / Friday, August 11 & 12 - Micro surfacing work has been scheduled between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. beginning on Thursday with completion Friday, weather dependent.

April 29, 2016

- Areas identified to receive micro surface are 140th Street from Cedar Avenue to Diamond Path, and The Oaks Neighborhood.
- Project bids are due May 19, 2016, with construction not scheduled to begin until July 2016.
