*** LEAGUE NOTES ***

- All games will be played at the Apple Valley Community Center, 14603 Hayes Road, Apple Valley. *Please car-pool as often as possible to alleviate congestion in the parking lot. League questions contact Lyndell Frey at Lfrey@cityofapplevalley.org or 952-953-2316.*
- A Single Elimination League Playoff will be held, (plus the losers of the 1st two games will play a consolation game beginning on January 4th & Jan. 11th, barring unforeseen circumstances such as winter storms (see item 8). Rosters are frozen at the end of regular season play. No players may be picked up for the play-offs. No league games on the following Wednesdays (due to Holidays) November 23, December 21 or December 28.**
- After 7 weeks of league play (8 games) each team will be seeded (1-5) for the play-offs. League Champions will receive t-shirts and a gift certificate. Playoff Champions and the League Runner-up will receive gift certificates. At the League Director's discretion, a team may be moved up or down in the Intermediate or Recreational division for the overall balance of league play for all teams.
- Adult Leagues are created for adult attendance only. If you MUST bring children to the game, a non-playing adult (no more than 2 children per 1 adult) must supervise them at all times. Players not adhering to this policy will not be permitted to participate in the game. For their own safety children must never be on the court.**
- Your League will be officiated. It is expected that players will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times! Misbehavior is grounds for suspension. Foul language and abusive behavior are violations of City of Apple Valley Park Code and are punishable as misdemeanor offenses. **Any player that is ejected from a game will be required to leave the facility immediately that player will also be required to miss his team's next scheduled game and pay a \$25.00 misconduct fee prior to being allowed to play in any other games. This is the minimum fine, if warranted a player may be suspended for a longer period of time at the league director's discretion.** If the player refuses to leave the facility within 3 minutes of expulsion his team manager must get him to leave if not the team will be penalized an additional team technical foul (the other team will be **awarded two points plus the ball. If the player still refuses to leave the game will be forfeited.**
- Players will be required to check in at the scoring table prior to the start of each game to confirm their name and number.**
- Random roster checks can be made at any time, at the discretion of the Gym Supervisor. All players must bring a picture ID to match the information listed on the team roster in order to be eligible to play. Teams will forfeit their game if players not on their roster participate.
- In the event of inclement weather (such as a severe snow storm), team managers should call the AVPR weather hotline after 4:30p.m. at [952-953-2399](tel:952-953-2399). If games are cancelled, they will be re-scheduled at the end of the regular season, prior to play-offs.**

- Teams in this league are eligible to play in the MRPA State Tournament. The class D (Recreational teams) is March 18 & 19 at the Lindbergh Center in Minnetonka.**

The tournament is set up with three team pools with single-elimination finals. Each team is guaranteed 2 games. Late registrations will be taken on a space available basis. Managers will receive tournament information via their league directors or directly 5-7 days prior to the tournament.
