

# Night to Unite 2023 Important Information



1. **Registration:** ONLINE ONLY. Visit City's website at [www.applevalleymn.gov/police](http://www.applevalleymn.gov/police). Click on the Night to Unite News Flash on home page. **THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER IS JULY 25.**
2. **Night to Unite Supplies:** Sidewalk chalk and CAUTION tape are available to registered parties. Please arrange to pick up at the Police Lobby the week of July 25-August 1, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. PLEASE DO NOT COME IN BEFORE JULY 25 TO COLLECT YOUR SUPPLIES. **(NO MONDAY PICK UP).**
3. **Crime Maps:** Crime maps will be emailed out to coordinators after the registration deadline. If you need yours printed, please email [pam.walter@applevalleymn.gov](mailto:pam.walter@applevalleymn.gov).
4. **Street Closure:** We will again be issuing CAUTION tape for street closures. If you indicated on your Night to Unite registration form that you will be closing a street, you will be able to pick up yellow "CAUTION" tape in the Police Department lobby and will tie that to objects (lawn chairs, garbage cans, bikes, etc.) at the end of your street for the closure. This is only good for NTU events.
5. **School Supply Drive:** We will be collecting school supplies to be given to students in need in ISD 196. School supplies should be collected at your gathering and turned in to Falcon Ridge Middle School August 3—11. See School Supply Flyer for more information.
6. **Chalk Art Contest:** Back by popular demand! Get your best Picasso's to adorn your neighborhood sidewalks, driveways, and/or streets with wonderful chalk art celebrating whatever you want! Take a photo of your creations and submit them to [Chalk Art Contest](#) for a chance to win a prize. Prizes will be awarded to the top three submissions. Submission rules can be found on the link. Please no more than 5 picture submissions per person.
