

Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley is a public, non-profit cemetery, owned and operated by the City of Apple Valley, dedicated to providing a respectful resting place for loved ones in a setting of dignity and peace, while providing a permanent place of remembrance for family and friends.

BURIAL CHOICES

Lebanon Cemetery recognizes the diversity of personal choice in determining one's final resting place and offers a variety of burial site locations and types. Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley offers a quiet, serene resting place where loved ones can enjoy the beautiful surroundings of a park-concept cemetery.

Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley offers four types of burial alternatives: traditional lawn burial, cremation lawn burial, cremation boulder, and columbarium niche.

TRADITIONAL LAWN BURIAL

Lebanon Cemetery offers marker and monument privileged traditional burial lots throughout its professionally manicured grounds.

CREMATION LAWN BURIAL

Cremation is becoming the personal choice of more people than ever before. To accommodate this growing need, Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley has developed specific lawn cremation sections.

Both marker and monument privileged cremation lawn burial gardens are available.

CREMATION BOULDER

The back to nature cremation memorial is a large piece of granite with receptacles designed to contain the cremated remains of the deceased. A bronze cover embossed with the deceased's name and dates of birth and death and an optional



emblem is placed over the receptacle. Please note, boulders are custom ordered and have a lead time of a few months.

COLUMBARIUM

A columbarium niche is a space in an above-ground structure designed for the specific purpose of interring cremated remains. Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley has four beautifully designed two-tone granite columbaria which contain both single and double niche spaces. A distinctive bronze plaque adorned with a wreath emblem and embossed with the deceased's name and years of birth and death, in polished lettering, is placed on the front of the niche space.



Individual and family niches in our attractive, stately columbaria may be purchased for memorializing cremated remains.

MEMORIALS

A loved one's grave may be memorialized with either a monument or marker depending on the lot selected. Lebanon Cemetery requires lots to be marked with a permanent monument or marker

within one year of interment. Permanently unmarked graves are not allowed. The City does not purchase or install markers or monuments. They may be purchased from a vendor of your choosing. All monuments and markers must meet Cemetery regulations.

MONUMENTS

A monument is a stone or other suitable material set above grade level and inscribed with the name of the deceased and any other pertinent information.

A monument may be placed on two or more lots in monument privileged rows. Monuments are not permitted on single lots or on lots not designated monument privileged.

MARKERS

A marker is a flat stone or other suitable material set at grade level and inscribed with the name of the deceased and any other pertinent information.

All lots are designated marker privileged. Markers may be placed on single or multiple lots.

MAINTENANCE

When you choose Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley, you can be confident your final resting place will be maintained with everlasting care. City staff schedules grounds cleaning from March to November. On these scheduled dates, plants and flowers that have died will be disposed as well as plants or decorations which have become unsightly, overgrown, dangerous, or diseased. Items that are not authorized will be removed.

LANDSCAPE BEAUTIFICATION FUND

The Apple Valley City Council established a Cemetery Landscape Beautification Fund. Donations will be used to purchase and plant approved species of shrubs, bushes, and trees in locations allocated for that purpose. Anyone wishing to donate to the Landscape Beautification Fund to memorialize a loved one should contact the City of Apple Valley.

Other personal remembrances must be in accordance with the policies, rules, and regulations set forth by the Apple Valley City Council.

PREPLANNING

It is wise to make important decisions regarding a final resting place before the time of need. Therefore, Lebanon Cemetery of Apple Valley encourages its patrons to select a final resting place before it is needed, as a service to oneself and to one's survivors.
